Participant and GPRA Breakdown (45)






Lessons Learned

- Be flexible and adapt to changing priorities
 - Transitioned some face-to-face events to on-line formats
 - Consider how to provide training in virtual environment(s)
 - Adapting evidence-based prevention to on-line formats
- Increased interest in on-line training & TA
 - Webinars: increased our capacity from 500 to 1000 participants
 - Prevention professionals request assistance in learning how to deliver services using technology
 - Use technology in engaging ways (e.g. breakout rooms, ask the experts)






