  - d. Other 

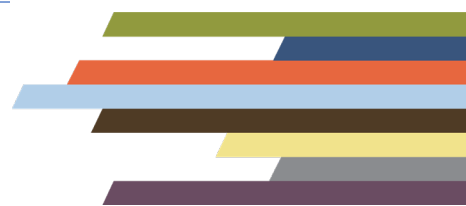
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3. Does your community have local policies that restrict the sale of specific alcoholic beverage products? If yes, please describe
