The spread of gender violence has reached levels of urgency such that the Governor of Puerto Rico, Pedro Pierluisi, declared a state of emergency for the island. While interpersonal violence is a global issue, this session focuses on how to support professionals who work with individuals within Hispanic/Latina communities who are experiencing gender-based violence.

This two-hour interactive webinar will identify the dynamics of Intimate Partner Violence, social services to support, explore how an on-site safety plan can be a resource for victims, and inform on culture and trauma informed strategies that support Latina victims of intimate partner violence.
