



LL+L Production Checklist¹

All Content

- Does the content introduce experiences in ways that entertain and teach about a topic in a creative way?
- Does the content provide opportunities for families to learn more about a topic, setting, culture or experience that is new to them?
- Is BIPOC adult and child talent diverse in their race, ethnicity, language, gender, age, class, physical features and ability?
- Is BIPOC adult and child talent meaningfully integrated as individuals?
- Is the content free of stereotypical representations?

Information

- Is the content accurate?
- Does the content reflect current research?
- Does the content support specific critical thinking skills?
- Does the content support specific social-emotional learning skills?

Story

- Does the story include authentic visual representation of BIPOC characters, environments and experiences?
- Does the story provide social or cultural context for the topic and skills being taught?
- Does the story artwork align with the text and narration?

Activities

- Does the instructor acknowledge creative alternatives to the materials used for activities?
- Are there appropriate instructions for those unfamiliar with the activity?
- Does the activity encourage creativity, making, and self-expression?

- Does the activity encourage multi-generational covieing, coplay, and media engagement?
- Does the activity inspire connection with family and/or community members?
- Are there resources to extend the activity's learning experience?

Audience

- Are BIPOC families authentically represented?
- Does the audience have opportunities to see themselves reflected in the content?
- Does the content address specific needs of BIPOC families?
- Does the media include a wider audience in common experience?
- Is the content age-appropriate for the intended audience?
- Are BIPOC families used in marketing images and messaging?
- Is the content available in multiple languages?
- Does the content address accessibility?

Caregiver Support

- Does the content include a Parent Tip?
- Does the Parent Tip offer suggestions for caregivers on how to support their child's learning and development in a way that is easy to understand?
- Does the content model supportive caregiver roles and behaviors?
- Does the content offer activity instructions and extension activities for caregivers?
- Does the content encourage caregivers and children to explore, learn, share and create together?
