
NLBHA's Mission






Electronic Cigarette or Electronic Smoking Device (ESD)






Early adolescence initiation - greater potential for addiction







Latin People in the USA Use is less than or equal to that of the general population


2018 National Survey on Drug Use and Health: Hispanics, Latino or Spanish Origin or Descent

PAST MONTH, 2015-2018 NSDUH, Hispanic 12+











Latin People in the USA Lower use than among white non-Latino youth



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



What to do to encourage healthy behaviors?

Risk factors


social
circumstances or
characteristics of
the person that
make them more
vulnerable to take
on risky behaviors
such as using drugs



Protective factors

counterbalance vulnerabilities, making the person less likely to assume this behavior.






Examples of risk and protection factors

Risk (increases vulnerability)		Protection (decreases vulnerability)
Low attachment to the community	Social and community context	Involvement in activities acceptance, recognition
Absence of clear rules	Family	Expression of affection Coexistence, Recognition
"Bullying"	School	Opportunities for interactions Healthy activities
Impulsivity	Individual	Social skills Emotional regulation







- ✓ Clear rules






Contextual Risk Factors Stress associated with immigrant status
