Alcohol Retail Monitoring: Includes local oversight of alcohol retail operations, such as regulating location of new retailers (outlet density) and imposing operating conditions.

Tax Sales: Includes local taxes on the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Days & Hours: Includes local authority to regulate days and/or hours of sale of alcoholic beverages. Social Host: Local prohibition on hosting underage drinking parties.
