If you've ever tossed a little stone in a calm lake, you know the ripples spread far and wide. The same is true of environmental (community-level) prevention efforts. The past ten years have ushered in radical changes to alcohol and cannabis policies. From the 2012 legalization of cannabis for adult recreational use in Colorado to the pandemic-related changes in home delivery of alcohol, there's been a seismic shift in the substance misuse landscape and the way prevention professionals must approach their work.
