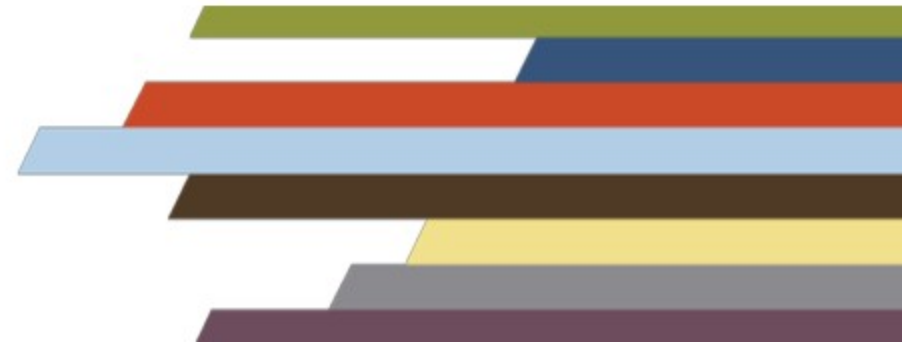

120 total prevention training hours (broken down into topics).


Px Ethics course.

Experience

2,000 hours in Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Drugs prevention (~1 year full time work)

Exam

Passing score on the IC & RC Prevention Specialist written test
